



Make your own Cat Ears!

There are at least three different ways to do this project: choose one and have fun!

1. Easy. Cut a strip long enough to go around your child's head. Tape or staple it into a circle. Tape or glue triangle-shaped ears to the front edge.
2. Harder. Add a 'cross-band,' and attach ears as directed. Link below with picture.
3. Easy. Cut a strip and make a band, as in #1. Draw an oval cat face with ears (or only the top half of the face). Cut it out and glue or tape it to the front of the band.

Headband – about 1” (two fingers) wide		
(if needed) add length to the Headband. Tape or staple to size of child’s head		
(optional) Cross-band, see picture, below.		
		Optional: face for #3, above  Add eyes, nose, ears, whiskers
