ULTIMATE BOOK NERD CHALLENGE OFFICIAL RULES 2020

50 BOOKS - IN 50 WEEKS - 50 CATEGORIES

- The Ultimate Book Nerd Challenge runs from January 5 to December 19, and is open to ages 13+.
- Quarterly Silent Book Club meetings (March 31, June 30, September 29, December 8) to get some reading time in!
 Open to all ages, participants and non-participants. Get one point for each Book Club meeting attended.
- Participants who complete the challenge win an "Ultimate Book Nerd" t-shirt.
- There are 60 categories, each participant must read 1 book in each of 50 categories to win – for each additional category/ book completed, participants will receive a raffle ticket for a grand prize drawing. Each book you read counts toward ONE category – the same book cannot be used in multiple categories.
- Books must be Middle Grade reading level (grade 4-8) or higher to count toward the challenge.
- All books read must be recorded in the online log by 11:59pm on December 19, 2020.
- Audiobooks count toward the challenge.
- Books must be started and completed within the contest time period.
- Sign-ups must be between January 5 and July 1, 2020.
- What needs to be recorded:
 - · Title and Author of book read
 - Date Started
 - Date Completed
 - Book rating (scale of 1-5?)
